ADVANCE WARNING OF NEWPORT CARNIVALS PROCESSION ROUTE AND THE IMPENDING ROAD CLOSURES FOR CARNIVAL DAY

**THE CARNIVAL IS TAKING PLACE IN THE HIGH ST, ST MARY ST,
PART OF STAFFORD ROAD AND PART OF AVENUE ROAD.**

1. The roads in the High Street vicinity are closed from 6 am to allow for setting up.
2. For the carnival and the procession the NO entry signs indicate road closures from approx. 6 am or 12.30 pm (procession route) until the procession has passed through the junction or the carnival has finished at 9.00 pm to allow for disassembly, when the roads will be opened by the marshalls.

The procession STARTS once again this year from Audley Avenue outside Burton Borough School

3. The main High Street (including Upper and Lower Bar) , St Mary Street ,part of Stafford Road, part of Avenue Road are closed from 6 am on Saturday until 9.00 pm on the evening of Sat 8th June.

(certain streets may open earlier once the area is clear)

4. ALL CAR PARKS ARE OPEN AS USUAL AND THE ENTRANCE INTO NEW STREET CAR PARK HAS HAD THE ONE WAY SYSTEM RELAXED TO ALLOW ACCESS FROM GRAVELLY DRIVE

5. Please do not to park on the procession route, or the carnival streets, on the morning of Saturday 8th from 6 am -this will help with road safety and allow the floats to pass through unhindered and also allow stall holders to set up in the area. **The police may enforce no parking restrictions .**

6. Would all road users please abide by the carnival marshals instructions and please remember that there are lots of children taking part in the procession.

7. ROADS TRAVELLED BY THE PROCESSION- Audley Avenue (1pm start) Avenue Road, High Street through to Lower Bar starting at 1 pm.

8. Please be aware that the **buses** into Newport will be delayed for a short while and those which usually stop in the high street will make their way to the car park for pick up and drop off via alternative routes.

9. There will be no vehicular access into the High Street after 6 am on Saturday 9th June unless prior arrangement have been made; only vehicles allowed to access will be for the set up and delivery connected with the carnival.

10. Water Lane will have 'no parking restrictions' in place during the day to allow 2 way access for traffic.
