- 10) **Safe Routes to Schools** – To consider options and discuss ways in which as a committee and with the support of full council, improvements to the road safety around the local schools can create a Safe Routes to Schools project by funding the installation of Zebra Crossings outside the Infants and Junior schools and also the Burton Borough School, with the aspiration to create a safe Pedestrian “priority” route to the High Street and also Shuker Field car park. – Cllr Garvey to brief.
- 11) **Parking Strategy Working Group (PSWG)** to receive any updates regarding the discussions with Haberdasher Adams Grammar in respect of the School Car Parking provision.
- 12) **Civil Parking Enforcement (CPE)** to receive any updates on feedback and reaction following the implementation CPE. Further discussion and information with particular regard to the 40-minute waiting time on the High Street, will be an agenda item on the full Town Council meeting scheduled for 8<sup>th</sup> April.
