Grave Type Description for Newport General Cemetery

<p>Please note: There are separate sections set aside at Newport cemetery, the different grave types are listed below.</p>	<p>Purchasers Signature/s and Date:</p>
<p>1. <u>LAWN GRAVE</u> This is the standard grave type in Newport Cemetery. Graves are laid out in rows in the lawned areas, and may be of a single or double depth.</p> <p><i>PLEASE NOTE: kerb sets and Underground brick or stonework are NOT permitted on the lawned areas. Floral tributes, vases etc. must only be situated in the HEADSTONE AREA. Lawn graves must have no memorials, fences, floral tributes, or vases placed directly over or on the grass/grave area. <p>2. <u>GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE GRAVE</u></p> <p>There are currently Four Garden of Remembrance areas in Newport Cemetery. These areas are for the burial of cremated remains. A small headstone can be positioned to mark the burial Place which is to be to Newport Town Council's specifications. The grave space maybe of single or double depth.</p> <p><i>PLEASE NOTE: Cremated remains must be placed directly into caskets, no plastic lining should be used. Floral tributes, vases etc., must only be situated in the HEADSTONE AREA. Fencing in the Garden of Rest areas is not permitted. <p>2. <u>WOODLAND AREA</u></p> <p>Each individual grave (single interments) will be carefully recorded on plans with each grave being identifiable by a unique microchip placed adjacent to the memorial tree. All burials in the woodland area should take place in a biodegradable coffin/casket. Cremated remains can also be buried in this area and the same requirements will apply.</p> <p><i>PLEASE NOTE: This area is a natural burial area, where our aim is to encourage wildlife and wildflowers and therefore, tributes left by the graveside and tied to memorial trees are NOT permitted. <p>3. <u>BABY/INFANT GRAVES</u></p> <p>A Specially designated Memorial Garden for the burial of babies and infants is available in Newport Cemetery. Individual graves (single interments) are set out in a lawn grave style.</p> <p><i>PLEASE NOTE: kerb sets and Underground brick or stonework are NOT permitted on the lawned areas. Floral tributes, vases etc. must only be situated in the HEADSTONE AREA. Lawn graves must have no memorials, fences, floral tributes, or vases placed directly over or on the grass/grave area.
