The Town Council has prepared the following response to its residents regarding the provision of its services during the current Coronavirus outbreak. The Guildhall Office will be closed to the Public. In line with government advice during the coronavirus outbreak a high percentage of staff will be working from home, during this period we will be handling all enquiries via email enquiries@newportsaloptowncouncil.gov.uk we will endeavour to respond to all queries as soon as possible.

Allotments – These will remain open to tenants.

Cemetery and Amenity Areas – We will continue to maintain these areas as normal and allow access to the public wherever possible. However, given the rapidly changing picture we may have to limit the services and access we can provide during this period.

We advise anyone using the public spaces and play areas and to wash your hands both directly before and after use.

Public Conveniences – are closed until further notice.

Street Lights – We will continue to monitor and report any street lighting faults.

Weddings – We will continue to monitor Government guidance with regard to Weddings and Civil Ceremonies and if you have a Wedding booked and have any concerns please contact the Guildhall and the Registrar.
