

**TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, NEWPORT & CHURCH ASTON)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING, STOPPING ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND REVOCATIONS)
ORDER 2019**

BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on XX , and may be cited as the Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Newport & Church Aston) (Prohibition of Waiting, Stopping, on street Parking Places and Revocations) Order 2019.
 2. The Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Newport) (Prohibition of Waiting, On Street Parking Places and Restriction of Stopping) Order 2013 shall cease to have the effect in so far as it relates to the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Four to this Order.
 3. (1) In this Order:-
 - "Authorised Parking Place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act;
 - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000.
 - "Parking Disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.
 - (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
 - (a) A Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-
 - (i) In the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
 - (b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
 - (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
4. (1) Nothing in Article 6 or 8 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedules One and Three to this order for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - (c) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or any other Authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) a vehicle, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) a vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the sides of the lengths of roads for so long as such waiting is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 6 or 8 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule One and Three to this Order, at any time.
- (3) Nothing in Article 6, 7 or 8 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle:
- (a) to wait upon an Authorised Parking Place
- (4) Nothing in Article 6 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of the lengths of roads referred to in Article 6 for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of length of road on the same day).
- (5) Nothing in Article 8 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc (on which the driver, or person in charge of the vehicle, has

marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the sides of the lengths of roads referred to in Article 8

5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment
6. Save as provided in Article 4 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One of this Order
7. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time on the sides of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Two of this order.
8. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am - 6.00pm on Monday to Saturday on the sides of the lengths of the roads specified in Schedule Three of this Order.
 - (a) For a longer period than 40 minutes; or
 - (b) If a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting by that vehicle.

**Schedule One
(No waiting at any time)**

1. Ashworth Way, Newport (both sides) from its junction with Granville Road for a distance of 10m
2. Cornmell Lea, Newport (both sides) from its junction with Meadow Road for a distance of 27m in a north westerly direction.
3. Crown Mews, Newport (the south-east side) from its junction with Beaumaris Road to a point 30m north-east of its junction with Beaumaris Road
4. Dark Lane, Church Aston (the east side) from a point 10 metres south of the centreline of its junction with Newtown, northwards for a distance of 25m
5. Granville Road, Newport (both sides) from a point 20m west of the centreline of its junction with Ashworth Way for a distance of 40m in an easterly direction
6. Lower Bar, Newport (the north-east side) from its centreline with Water Lane in a south-easterly direction to a point 30m south-east of its junction with Salter Lane.
7. Newtown, Church Aston (both sides) east of its junction with Dark Lane for a distance of 10m
8. Stafford Road, Newport (both sides) from the eastern kerbline of Audley Road for a distance of 45m in a north-easterly direction
9. Stafford Road, Newport (the north side) from a point 10m west of the centreline of the junction with Vineyard Drive for a distance of 43m in an easterly direction
10. Vineyard Drive, Newport (both sides) from its junction with Stafford Road for a distance of 10m in north westerly direction
11. Waterside Mews, Newport (the south side) from its junction with Salters Lane to a point 36m west of its junction with Salters Lane

**Schedule Two
(No Stopping – At any time)**

1. Salters Lane, Newport (the north-west side) from its junction with Waterside Mews for a distance of 25.5m in a north-easterly direction

**Schedule Three
(Parking Places - Time Limited Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 40 Minutes - No Return Within 1 Hour)**

1. Lower Bar, Newport (the north-east side) from a point 30m south-east of its junction with Salter Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 44m.

SCHEDULE FOUR – Revocations

Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Newport) (Prohibition of Waiting, On Street Parking Places and Restriction of Stopping) Order 2013

Schedule One – (Prohibition of Waiting)

1. Lower Bar, (the north-east side) from its junction with Water Lane to a point approximately 37m South-east of the centreline of Salters Lane.

Schedule Two - (On Street Parking Places) Monday-Saturday - 8am-6pm - 40 Minutes No Return Within 1 Hour

1. Lower Bar, (the north-east side) from a point approximately 37m south east of the centreline of Salters Lane for a distance of approximately 30m in a south easterly direction.
